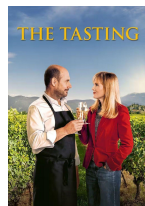


The Mule

A 90-year-old horticulturist and Korean War veteran turns into a drug mule for a Mexican cartel.

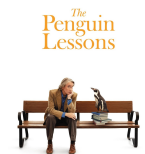


The Tasting
